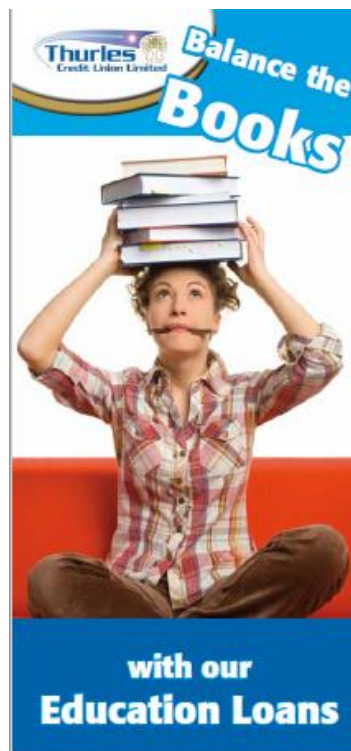

Applying for a loan

Parents who wish to apply for an educational loan to fund the purchase of an IPAD should do the following:

- Set up an account with TCU if they are not already a member.
- Establish a regular savings pattern for 6/8 weeks.
- Loan should be put over a maximum loan term of 3 years.
