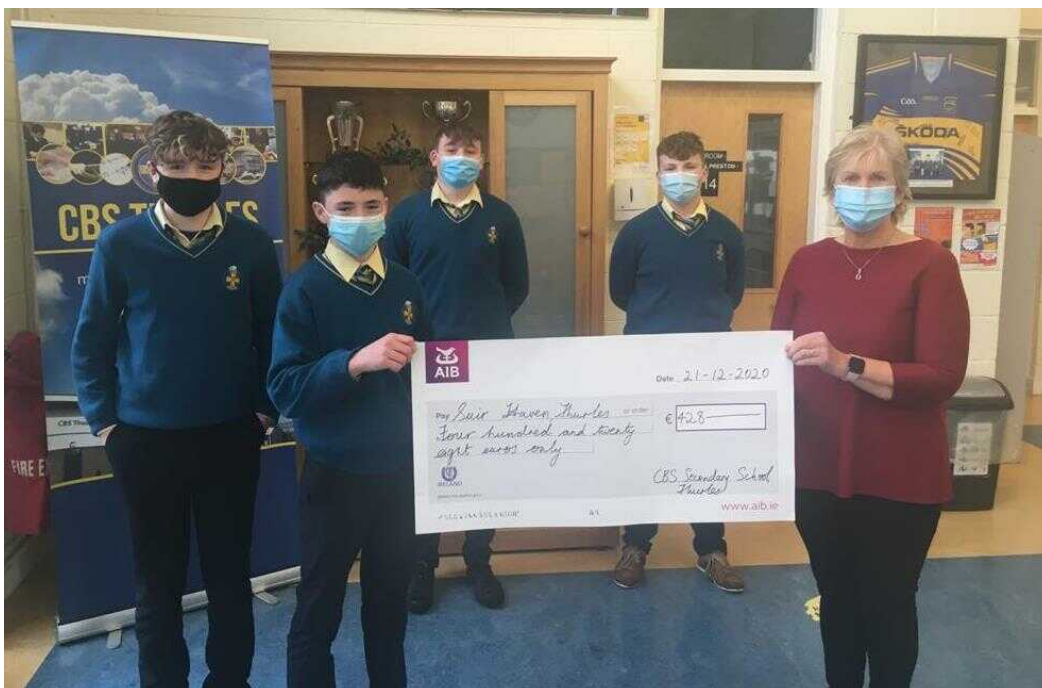
St Vincent de Paul
