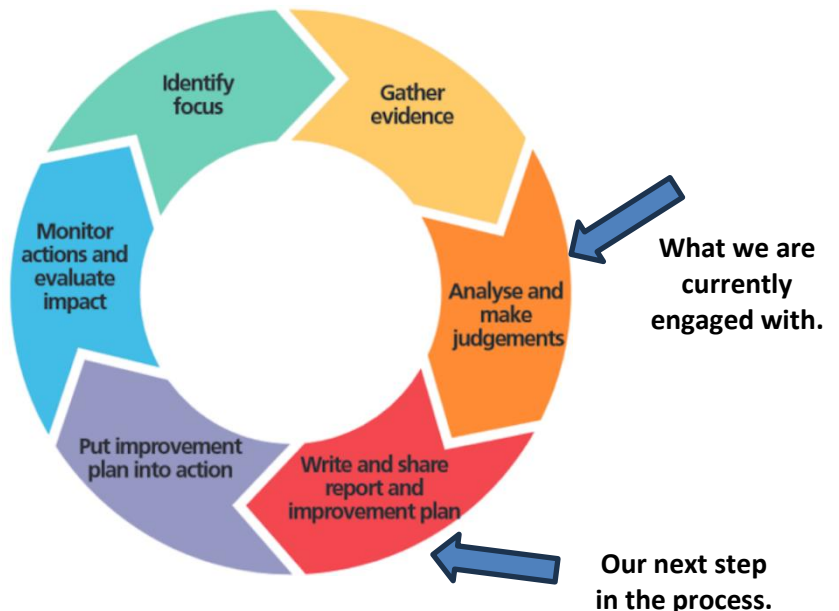
### SSE FOCUS AREA – Teaching & Learning with 1-hour classes

#### School Self-Evaluation – Six Step Process

This diagram sets out the six-step School Self-Evaluation Process which has been used by schools since the introduction of SSE in the Irish school system.

In CBS Thurles, we have begun a new cycle of School Self-Evaluation in relation to Learning & Teaching this year and are currently working through **Step 3: Analyse and make Judgements**

The analysis of the data will capture a clear focus on what is working and what may need to be looked. This process will involve the perspectives of our school community.
